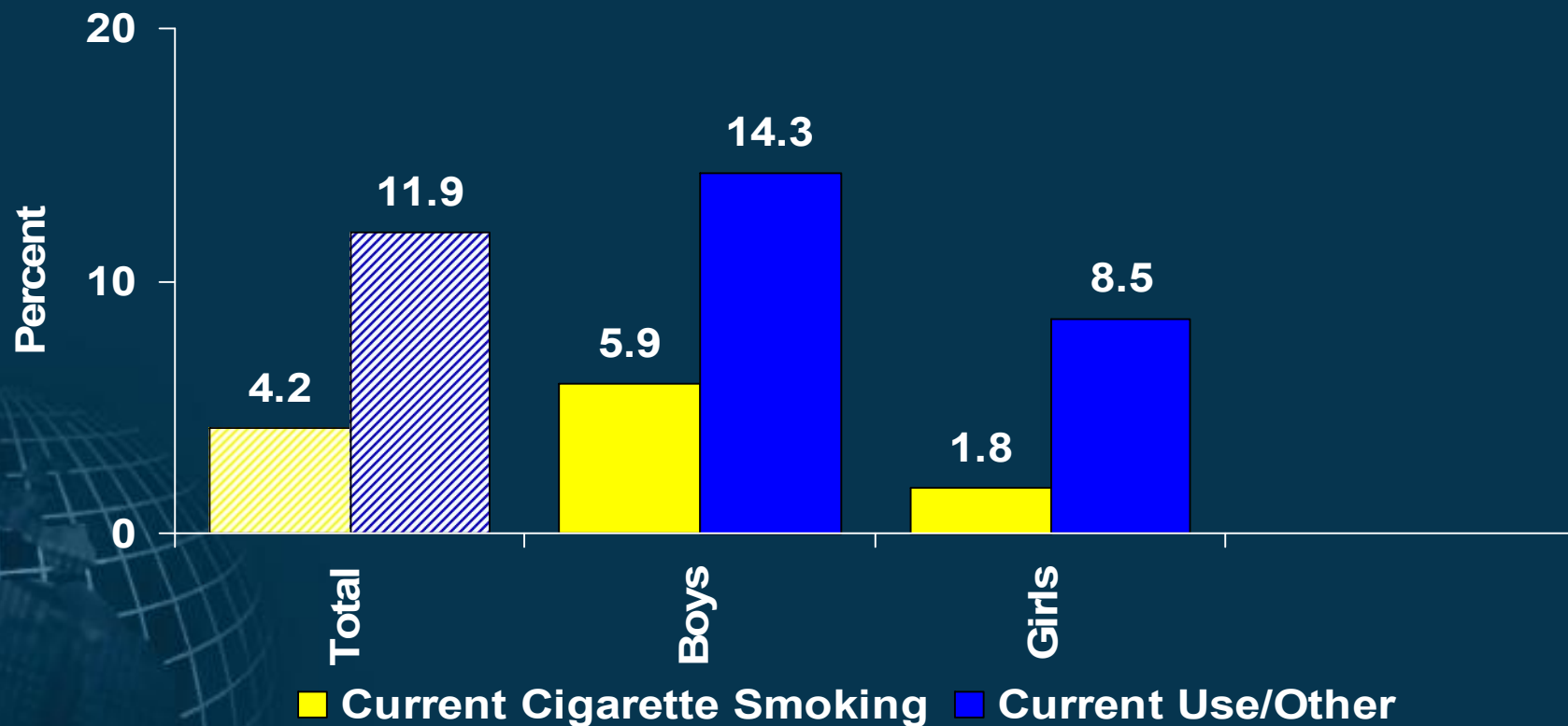


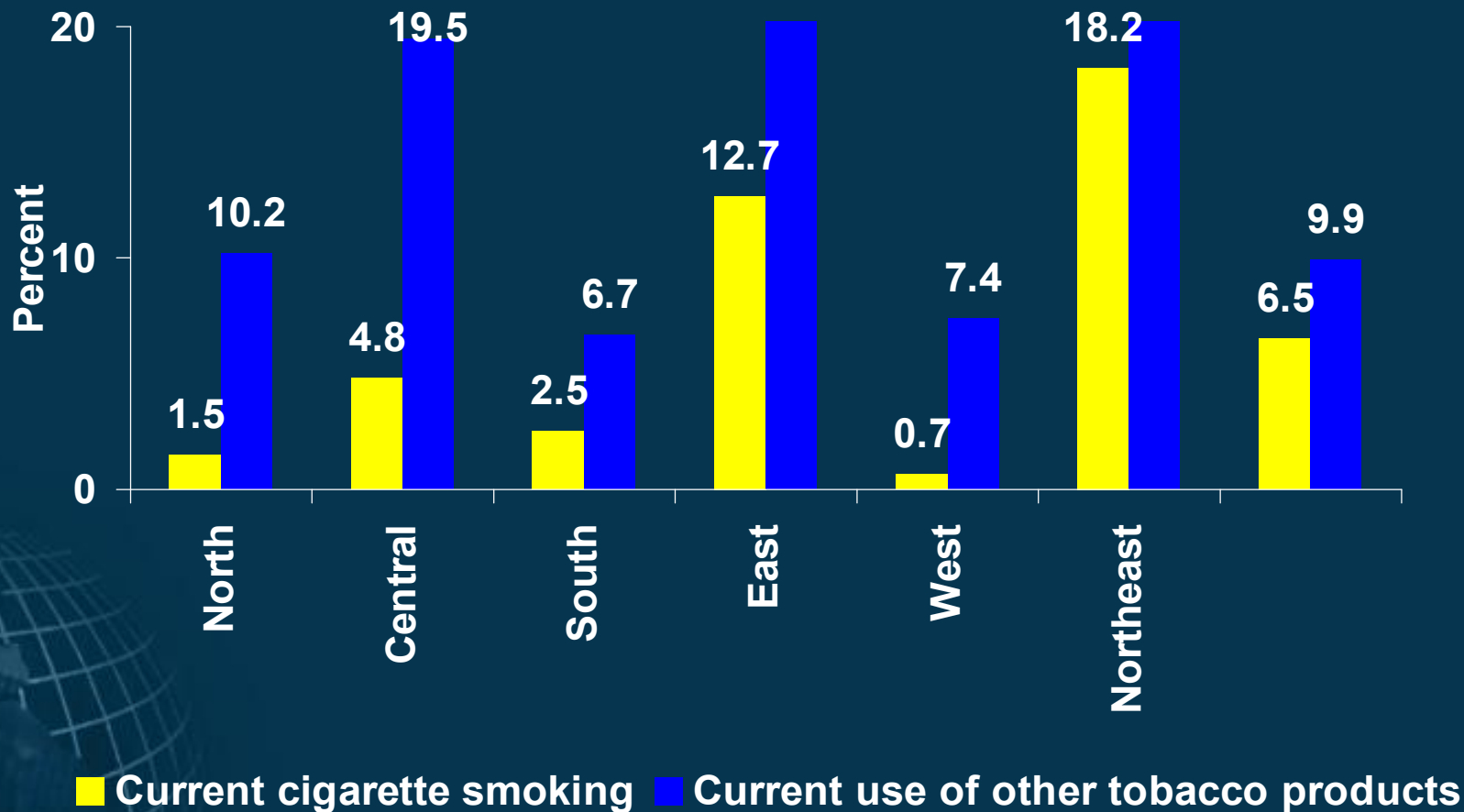

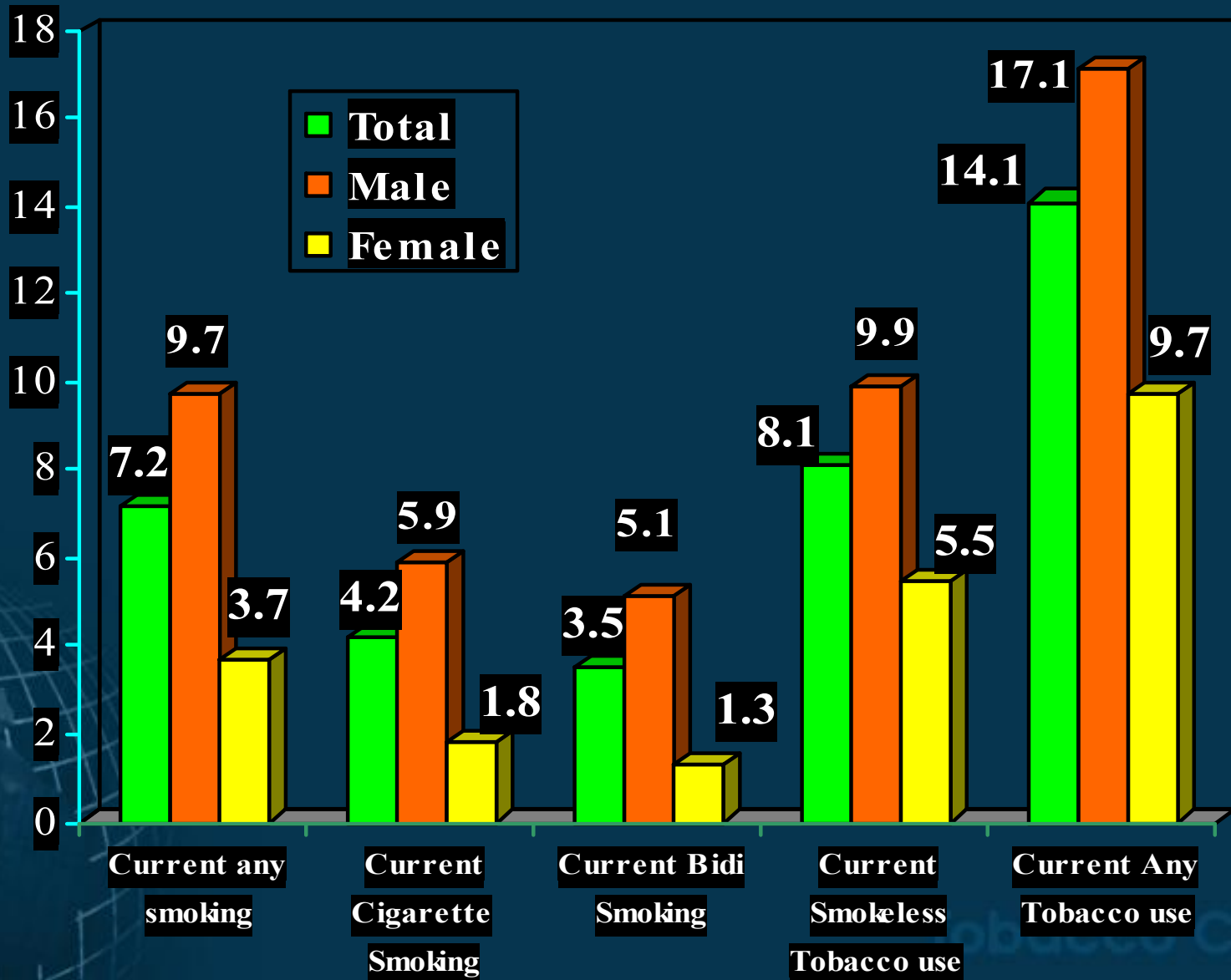
Percent Current Cigarette Smoking and Current Use of Other Tobacco Products by SEX – India, Global Youth Tobacco Survey, 2006



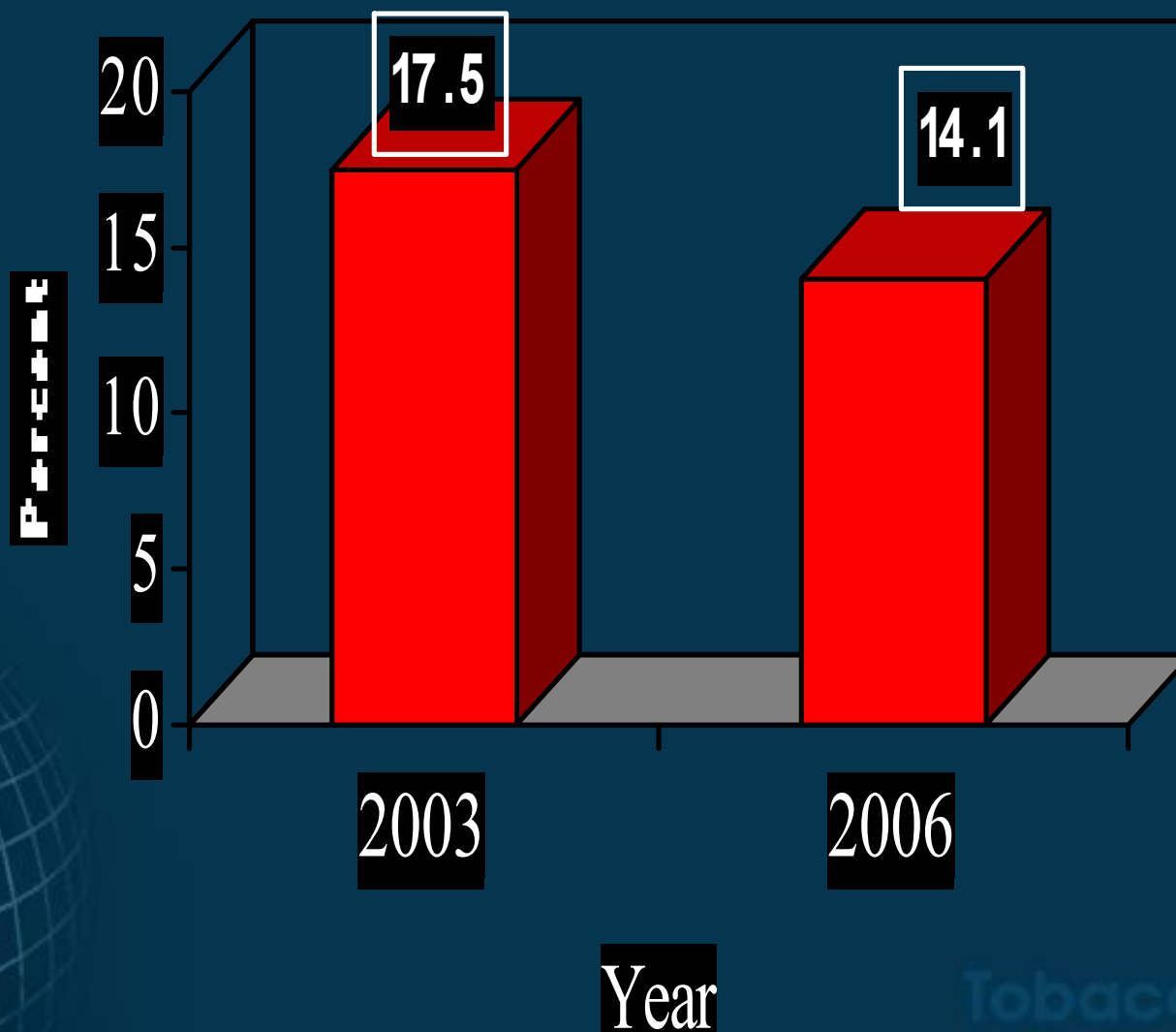
Percent Currently Smoking Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products by Region – India Global Youth Tobacco Survey, 2006

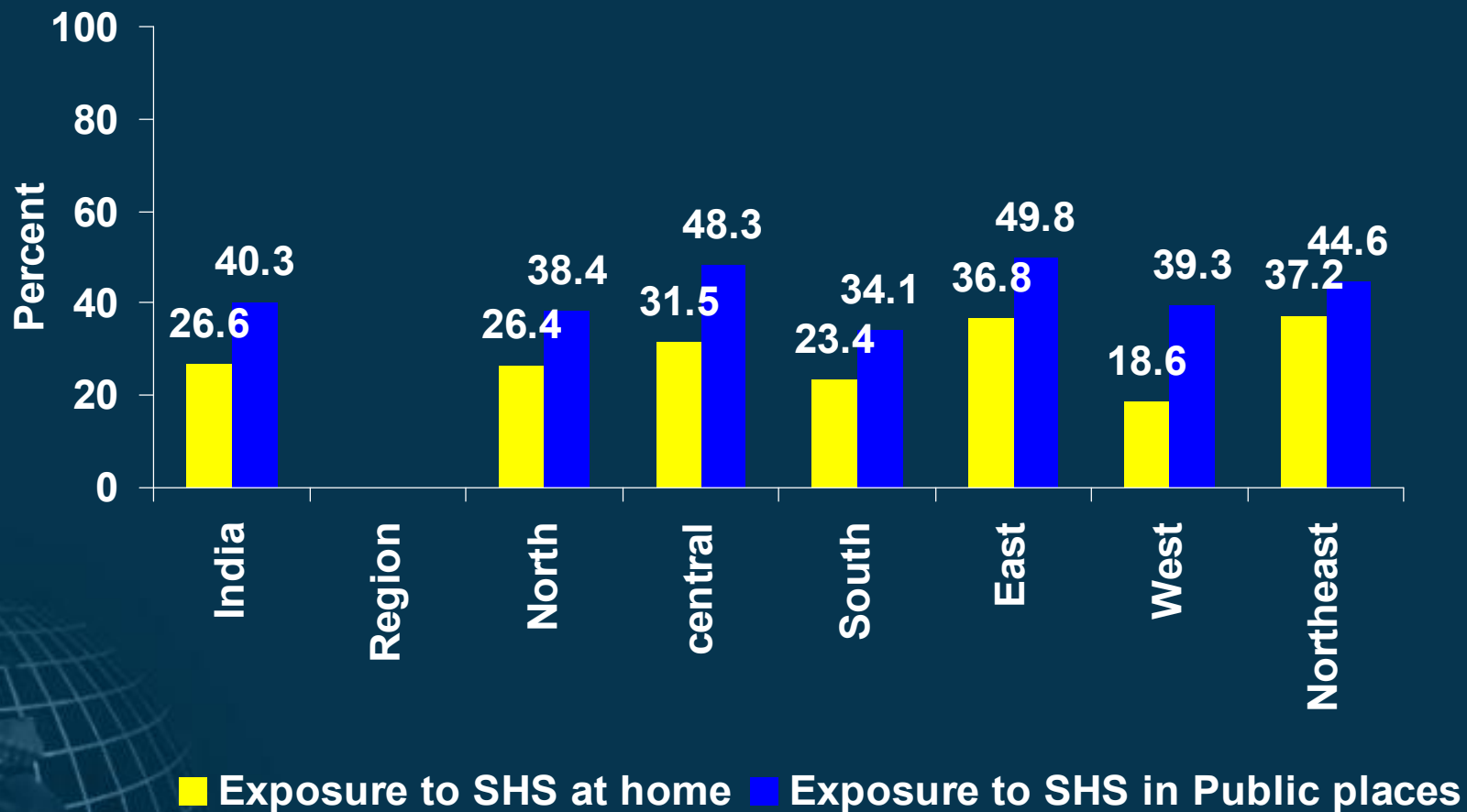

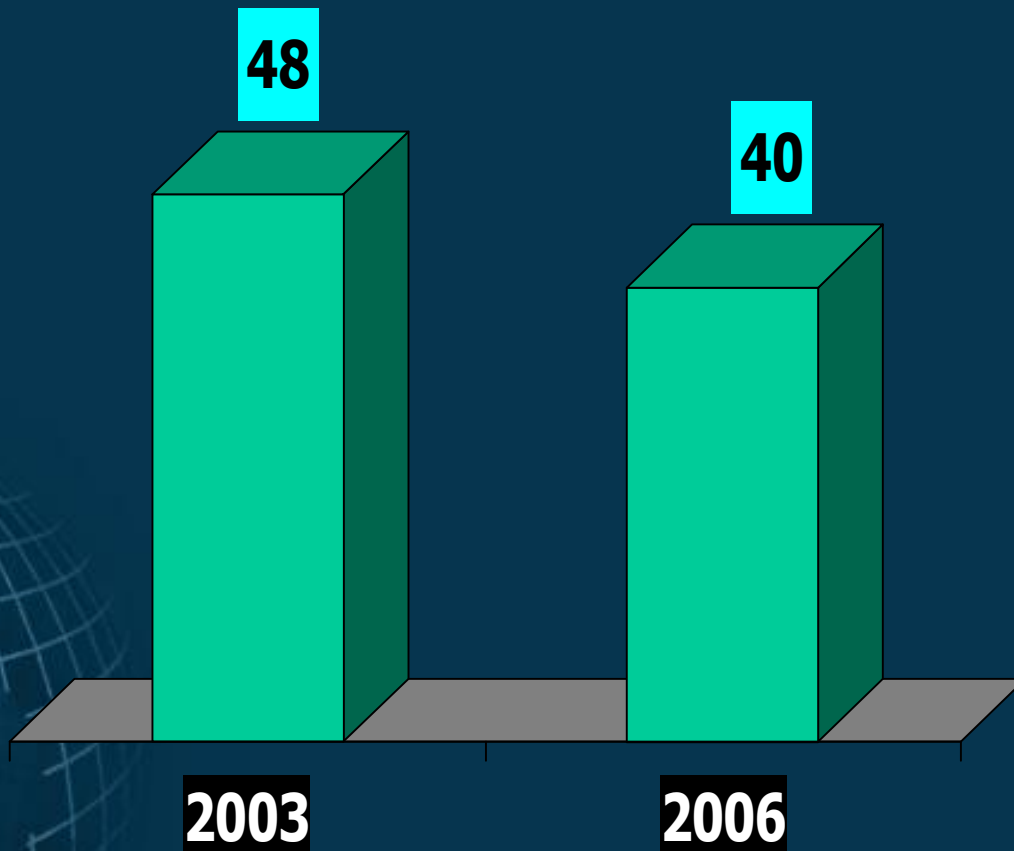

Exposure to SHS at Home and in public places by Region -- Global Youth Tobacco Survey, 2006

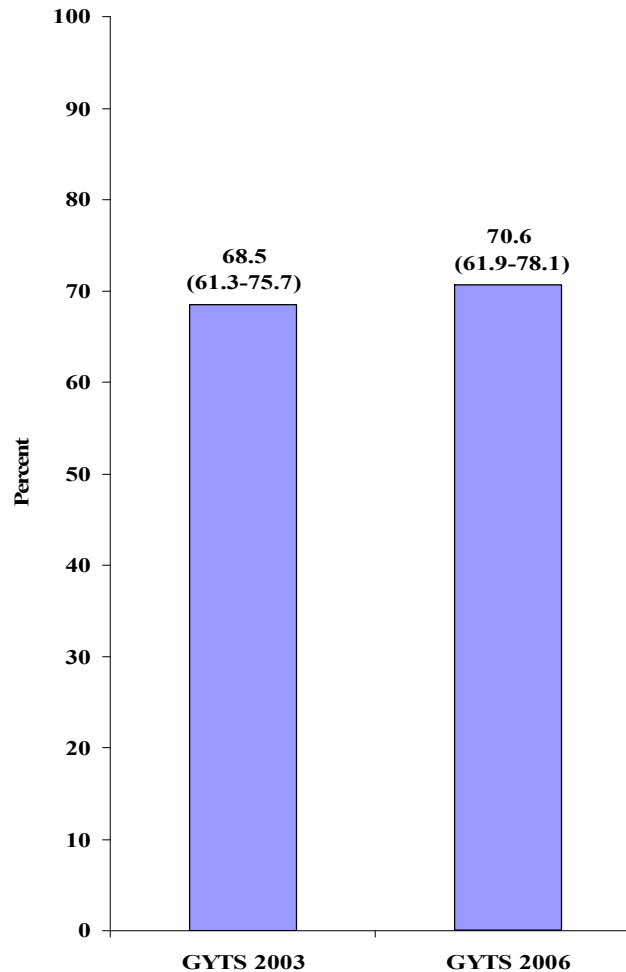


■ Exposure to second hand smoke in public places by year

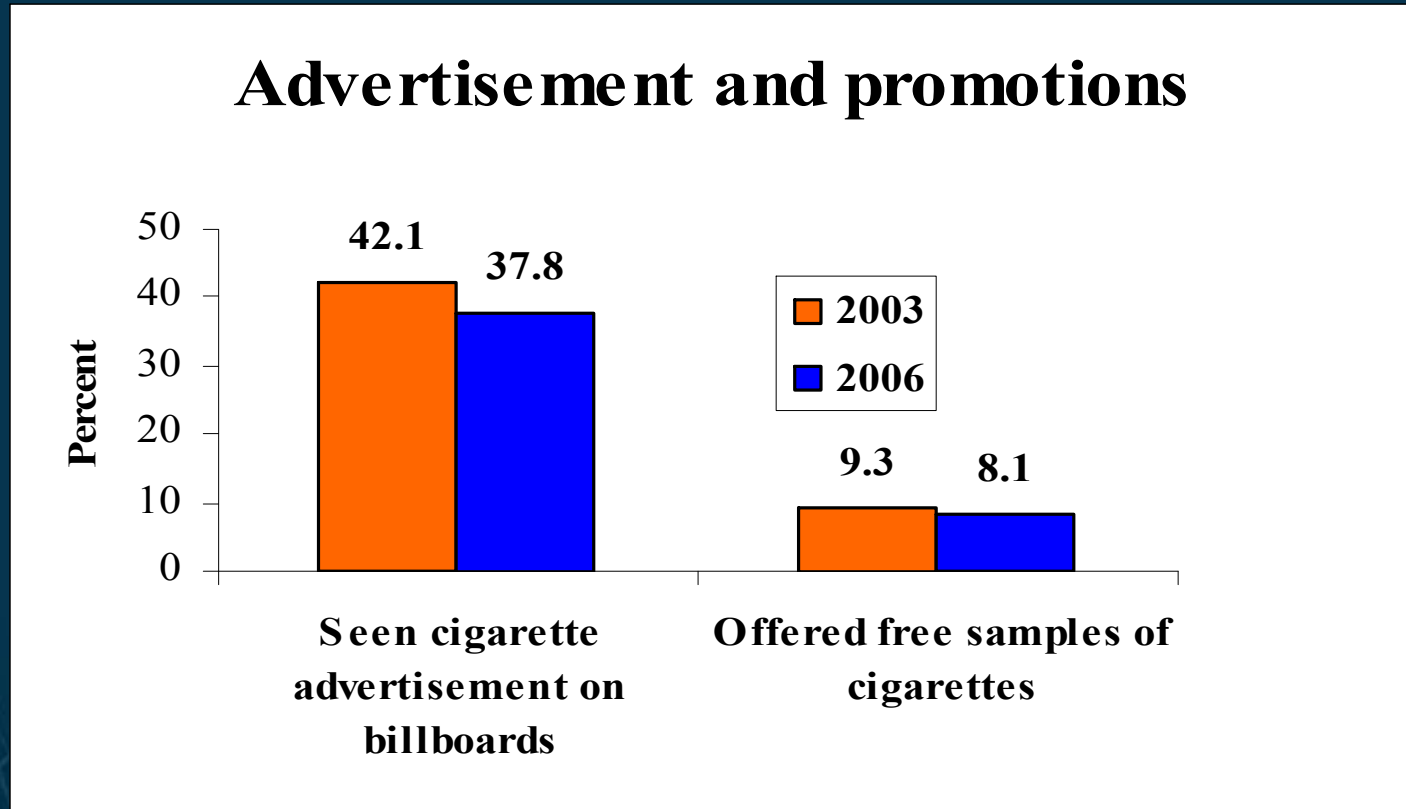


Current Smokers and Cessation Attitude through years -- Global Youth Tobacco Survey, 2003-2006

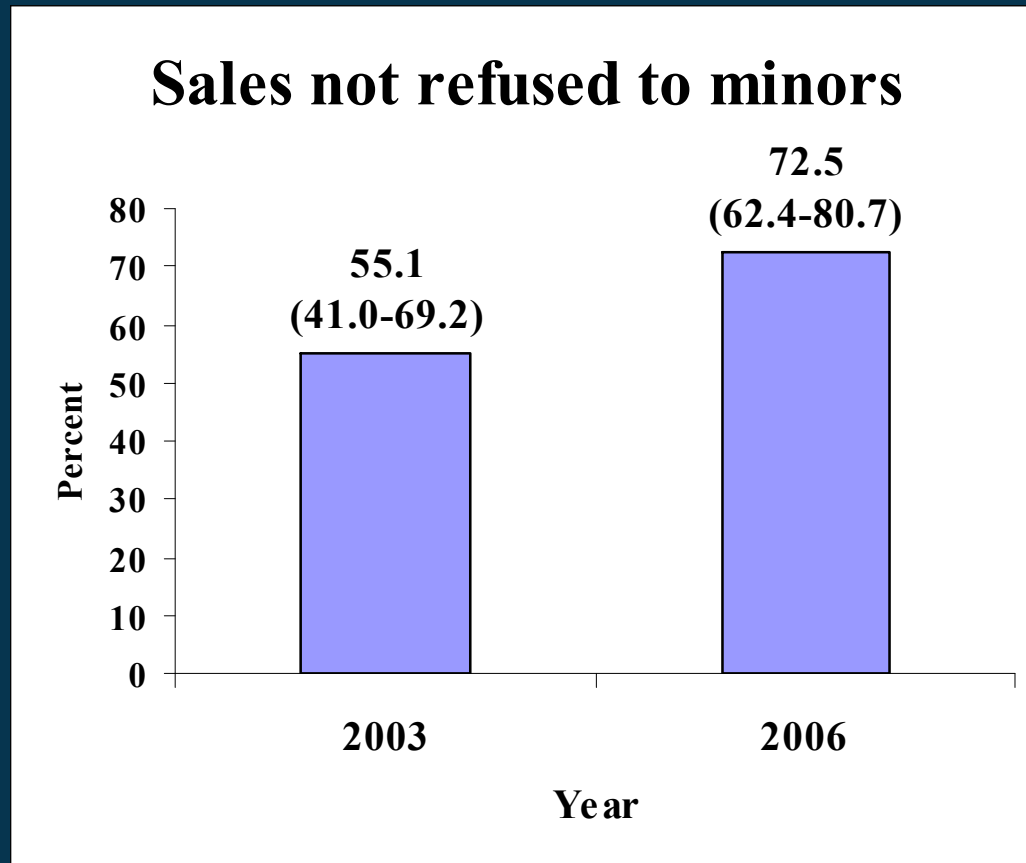
Figure 11- Current smokers who wants to quit smoking, India GYTS 2003 & 2006

- HIGH PREVALENCE OF TOBACCO USE AMONG STUDENTS
- INCREASING USE AMONG GIRLS
- NO CHANGE INTOBACCO USE IN 3 YEARS
- HIGH SHS EXPOSURE
- REDUCTION IN SHS EXPOSURE IN PUBLIC PLACES IN 3 YEARS
- ADVERTISEMENT AND PROMOTION WITHOUT CHANGE
- NO CHANGE IN ACCESS TO MINORS
- **STRICTER IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY AND MORE EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN**
