

Fiscal Year 2025 Report to Congress **(July 2024–June 2025)**

The CDC Foundation experienced a successful year of significant program accomplishments during the period of July 2024–June 2025.

The CDC Foundation is an independent nonprofit authorized by Congress to mobilize philanthropic partners, corporations, organizations and individuals to support critical health protection efforts. In this role, the CDC Foundation is focused on one priority—helping the public health community, including the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), improve the health and lives of people on a population basis. Since 1995, the CDC Foundation has launched nearly 1,500 programs and raised more than \$2.60 billion to support those programs. The CDC Foundation managed 228 programs in the last year.

The Foundation had a highly impactful resource mobilization and programmatic year during the period of July 1, 2024–June 30, 2025 (FY 2025) in its efforts to extend the lifesaving work of the public health system, including CDC. Below are program highlights, financial highlights and a listing of funders. For the nineteenth year in a row, the CDC Foundation received a 4-star rating from Charity Navigator, the nation’s largest and most utilized evaluator of charities. In this latest evaluation, the Foundation received a perfect score of 100—the highest possible rating—for its financial efficiency, trustworthiness and transparency, as well as its leadership and adaptability.

Program Highlights

Mobilizing Communities: Reducing Overdose Deaths

According to provisional data from CDC, more than 80,000 people died from drug overdose in the United States in 2024, representing a nearly 27 percent decline in overdose deaths compared to 2023. The drop was driven by a number of factors,

including the strategic distribution of naloxone, the emergency medicine designed to rapidly reverse the effects of opioids.

The CDC Foundation's Overdose Response Strategy (ORS) program, an innovative partnership between public health and public safety, is working at the community level to help reduce drug overdoses. Currently, there are 61 two-person ORS teams across the United States and its territories who gather and analyze data on overdoses and advise jurisdictions on the latest overdose prevention and response strategies.

Additionally, as part of CDC's Overdose Data to Action (OD2A) program, designed to enhance drug overdose prevention efforts through data, the CDC Foundation supported more than 200 field staff stationed across 45 jurisdictions in fiscal year 2025. Working on behalf of health departments across the nation, these staff assist with essential public health responses, provide clinicians with the data they need to improve prescribing practices and foster coordination across sectors to support linkage to treatment and long-term recovery. CDC cited OD2A as one of the programs helping to contribute to the overall decline in overdose deaths in 2024.

Separately, with funding from the Georgia Opioid Crisis Abatement Trust, the CDC Foundation launched a new program in fiscal year 2025 to support rural Georgia communities in strengthening public health–public safety partnerships to address overdose, informed by lessons from ORS. Through this two-year project, *Building Partnerships to Address Overdose in Rural Georgia*, 18 rural community coalitions covering 21 counties are implementing community-driven projects proposed through their applications, with technical assistance and training from the CDC Foundation to build capacity and promote sustainability beyond the funding period.

A Healthy Start: Improving Neonatal Nutrition

Our health in adulthood is shaped during the earliest moments of life, and poor nourishment in the womb increases the chance of developing chronic diseases as we age. The CDC Foundation's work in promoting perinatal nutrition is rooted in the science of the *Developmental Origins of Health and Disease*, which has found that poor nutrition at critical periods of development alters the structure and function of the body's organs and systems, increasing our vulnerability for adult disease. This body of science shapes our strategy for addressing malnourishment before, during and after pregnancy.

Organizations across the United States are integrating this research into their strategies to improve nutrition and health outcomes, and the CDC Foundation, with critical and

ongoing support from Vitamix Foundation, brings more than 50 of these organizations together as part of the CDC Foundation's Hunger, Nutrition and Health in Pregnancy Action Network. Convening to leverage their strengths and resources and create opportunities for greater impact, these organizations work together on solutions to the many complex problems around hunger and nutrition for expecting families and families with young children, expanding each organization's reach and impact.

This collaboration includes a quarterly virtual meeting where participants can learn more about the research that grounds this work, network with other maternal health professionals, hear inspiring success stories and provide input that will help guide the network's future actions and priorities.

Driving Data Modernization: The Workforce Acceleration Initiative

Across the nation, many of today's public health systems are running on yesterday's technologies and out-of-date information and data connections. Improving this digital infrastructure requires updated equipment, new policies and the addition of skilled technical professionals at all levels.

The Workforce Acceleration Initiative (WAI) focuses on providing the data and technology experts needed to accelerate these information system improvements and bolster the ability of public health agencies to serve all communities. In fiscal year 2025, 49 public health agencies (PHAs) were selected and more than 125 professionals were placed by the CDC Foundation through the program. These professionals are helping PHAs modernize and integrate their data systems, better equipping them to respond to new threats, make more informed and timely decisions, and deliver healthier outcomes for the populations they serve.

Safeguarding Health: Antibiotic Stewardship to Address Resistance

Antibiotics are one of the most powerful tools in medicine. Over time however, inappropriate antibiotic use—like prescribing antibiotics when not needed during outpatient visits—can allow pathogens to develop the ability to withstand the drugs designed to target them. This antimicrobial resistance complicates infection treatment and makes medical procedures like surgery much riskier.

While healthcare professionals are responsible for prescribing antibiotics, healthcare payers, including Medicaid agencies, play a critical role in healthcare quality improvement and are uniquely positioned to track antibiotic use.

Medicaid agencies maintain patient-level prescribing data without personally identifiable information that can inform antibiotic stewardship priorities. With this data in hand, health departments gain insight into when antibiotics are being prescribed and for what conditions. After analyzing both state- and provider-level trends, health departments can share the data with providers and clinics and encourage a responsible approach to antibiotic use.

With support from The Pew Charitable Trusts, the CDC Foundation, in partnership with CDC's Office of Antibiotic Stewardship, works with state Medicaid programs and health departments to encourage this collaboration and data sharing. In 2021, CDC released *Improving Outpatient Antibiotic Prescribing: A Toolkit for Healthcare Payers*, which provides a framework for how healthcare payers can implement antibiotic stewardship activities. The CDC Foundation is developing a supplement to this toolkit that highlights successful partnerships between health department antibiotic stewardship teams and state-level Medicaid agencies.

The CDC Foundation and CDC provide technical assistance to health department stewardship teams on how to establish and strengthen partnerships between Medicaid agencies and state health departments, inviting health department antibiotic stewardship teams to come together to collaborate, share lessons learned and address challenges in implementing stewardship activities. This project gives health departments practical tools to work with both Medicaid agencies and providers and clinics in their jurisdiction to address the growing crisis of antibiotic resistance.

Serving Those Who Served: Preventing Veteran Suicide

Suicide is a serious and growing problem in the United States. Veterans are at higher risk for suicide than the general population. Many face unique challenges including stress from relationships, health issues, substance misuse, financial problems or trouble finding housing or jobs. In 2022, suicide was the twelfth-leading cause of death for veterans and was the second-leading cause of death for veterans under 45 years of age, according to the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs.

Suicide is rarely caused by any single factor, which means there are multiple opportunities for prevention. That's where Veteran-Serving Organizations (VSOs) play a critical role. These organizations provide essential programs and services that help address the root causes of suicide risk, offering support with employment, housing, education, life skills, mental health and community connection.

The Veteran Suicide Prevention Evaluation (VSPE) Program is designed to help VSOs evaluate and improve programs that reduce suicide risk among veterans. Having partnered on the program since 2018, the CDC Foundation and CDC were joined in 2024 by Safe States Alliance, bringing their strong network and expertise in injury and violence prevention to further support this work.

Through these partnerships, the CDC Foundation supported a total of 24 VSOs to date, helping them improve evaluation practices, apply proven strategies for suicide prevention and communicate their impact. To expand the program's reach, the VSPE Resource Hub was launched during this fiscal year, which is a growing collection of resources designed to make program evaluation more accessible and actionable for the wider VSO community.

Financial Information

For the year ending June 30, 2025, total grants and contributions received by the CDC Foundation were \$176.8 million and consisted of: \$63.2 million from foundations; \$9.7 million from other organizations and individuals; \$5.1 million from corporations; and \$98.8 million in federal, state and jurisdictional grants and contracts. The majority of these contributions were restricted to the following program focus areas: \$18.2 million for infectious disease; \$22.5 million for global health; \$36.0 million for chronic disease and birth defects; \$64.6 million for public health workforce; \$24.0 million for injury and violence (including programming to reduce opioid overdoses); and \$11.5 million for other areas.

The Foundation also received federal funding of \$1.25 million for the year ending June 30, 2025, to help defray administrative costs to the Foundation. This funding was primarily used to fund the costs of the staff who were responsible for building the partnerships that generated \$176.8 million in support of programming.

The Foundation is the recipient of certain cost-reimbursable grants that are subject to conditions and restrictions typically met by incurring qualifying expenses for a program. Revenue is recognized for these grants as allowable expenditures are incurred. Of the \$176.8 million of grants and contributions received in Fiscal Year 2025, \$96.7 million represents conditional cost reimbursement grants that will be recognized as contribution revenue in future periods. As of June 30, 2025, the Foundation had total assets of \$158.6 million; total liabilities of \$17.8 million; and total net assets of \$140.8 million. The majority of these net assets were restricted by the donors to fund specific projects for CDC or the public health system. For the year ending June 30, 2025, the Foundation generated total contributions and other revenues for financial reporting purposes of \$168.3 million and incurred total program costs and other expenses of \$175.2 million. These program costs and other expenses consisted of \$17.1 million in

project grants; \$136.5 million in other program costs (primarily for workforce solutions and capacity building for opioid response); \$17.2 million for management and general expenses; and \$4.4 million in fundraising costs.
